Passenger numbers on our Fab 56 have increased considerably since we launched the service. We are now looking to increase capacity to give you a bus every ten minutes on Monday to Saturday daytimes. Buses would continue to run every 20 minutes on Sunday daytimes and every 30 minutes in the evening.

If we increase the service to run every ten minutes 2 we will provide improved connections at Concord (for Heworth and Galleries), Sunderland (for Seaham, Silksworth, Houghton-le-Spring and South Shields) and at Gateshead (for MetroCentre and Team Valley). Are there any other destinations for which we should provide better connections?

Gateshead Interchange can be very congested at 3 peak times and we are looking to operate some journeys direct to Newcastle via Gateshead High Street. We are concerned that passengers changing onto other buses and Metro services at Gateshead might be inconvenienced if we do not operate via Gateshead Interchange.
