## Wardley Consultation - Fab 57 & Pulse

In May 2012 we consulted customers about re-instating the direct links to Heworth Metro from Wardley, Ellen Wilkinson Estate and Beacon Lough by making changes to the Fab 57 and Pulse Services. **751** people took part in the survey providing an excellent sample of customers' views.

The key findings were as follows:

- 72% of the respondents were either 'in favour' or 'strongly in favour' of our plans to re-instate the direct links to Heworth via our Fab 57 Service. Only 12% of respondents were either 'against' or 'strongly against' this.
- **69%** of respondents said that they would prefer the Fab 57 to run every 20 minutes and continue serve Newcastle. **23%** of respondents would prefer the Fab 57 to run every 15 minutes but terminate at Gateshead.
- 35% of respondents said that they were either 'in favour' or 'strongly in favour' of our proposal to replace the fab 57 with the 69 and 69A operating in a circular route via mereside, Lingey Lane, Leam Lane, Wardley bus gate, Wardley Terminus, Sunderland Road, White Mere Gardens, Manor Gardens, Kirkwood Gardens, Kier Hardie Avenue, Kirkwood Gardens, LingeyLane, and Meresyde. 12% of respondents were either 'against' or 'strongly against' this. The remaining 53% either had no view or it chose 'This does not affect me'.

Several other comments were made in the consultation, although not in response to the specific questions. There were **two** particular themes in the points made

- Newer Buses on the 69/69A
- More Frequent 69/69A services

We will be making several changes to the Diamond Highwayman Services from **Sunday 29 July 2012**, as follows

- We are changing the route of the Fab 57 to run via Colegate, High Heworth Lane, Heworth Metro and Felling by-pass to re-instate the direct link to Heworth Metro, for interchange to connect bus and metro services.
- Service 57 will continue to serve Newcastle however will run every 20 minutes during the day time. Evening buses will continue to operate every 30 minutes.
- There will be no change to the route of the 69/69A, although there will be some minor changes to the timetable to improve the reliability of some journeys.
- Unfortunately we're not able to run more buses on the 69/69A services at the
  present time and the single deck buses introduced last year will continue to be
  used.
