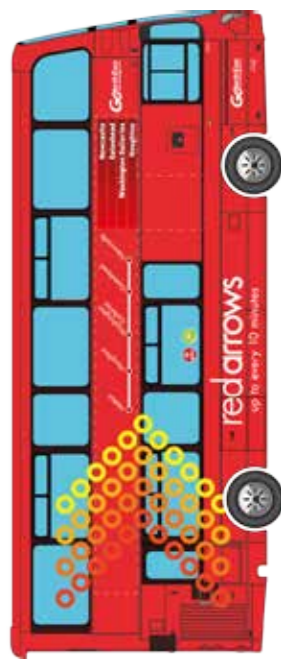

Where to catch your red arrows bus:

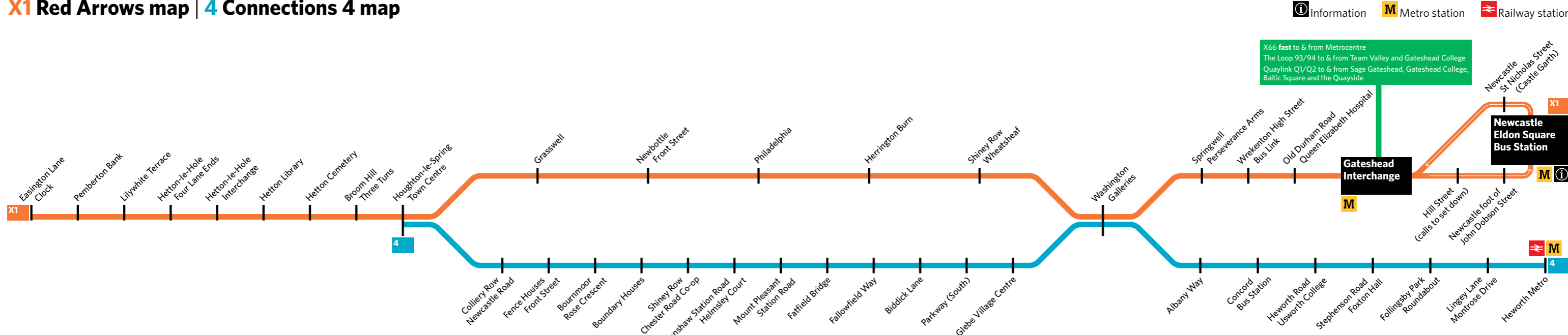
X1 runs limited-stop calling at Newcastle Eldon Square Bus Station, Newcastle St Nicholas Street (Castle Garth), Gateshead Interchange, Old Durham Road Traveller's Rest (for Queen Elizabeth Hospital), Wrekenton High Street Bus Link (Post Office), Springwell Village Perseverance Arms and Washington Galleries Bus Station, then calls at all bus stops between Shiny Row Eden Terrace (Wheatstheaf) and Easington Lane High Street (Clock).

Most red arrows X1 buses connect at Washington Galleries with Connections4 buses to Hatfield, Penshaw, Shiny Row, Bournmoor, Fence Houses and Houghton-le-Spring. For details of bus times, please pick up a copy of the Connections4 bus guide.

Timing points shown in bold print are designated stops where our drivers may need to wait to keep the service on schedule and your patience is appreciated when this is necessary.

Explanation of codes: A - Starts from Picktree Village at 0620 and runs via Rickleton, Harraton, Fatfield Bridge and Fallowfield Way to Washington Galleries. B - Starts from Picktree Village at 0705 and runs via Rickleton, Harraton, Fatfield Bridge and Fallowfield Way to Washington Galleries. RB - Runs additionally via Rainton Bridge Business Park at 2007, omitting the bus stops at Hetton Road Cemetery and Hetton Road/Longlands Drive.

Where to catch your red arrows bus: X1 calls at all bus stops between Easington Lane High Street (Clock) and Shiny Row Beatrice Terrace (Auto Parts Centre), then runs limited-stop, calling at Washington Galleries Bus Station, Springwell Village Perseverance Arms, Wrekenton High Street Bus Link (Co-operative), Old Durham Road Ambulance Station (for Queen Elizabeth Hospital), Gateshead Interchange, Gateshead Hill Street (to set down), Newcastle foot of John Dobson Street (Venue) and Newcastle Eldon Square Bus Station. X1A calls at all bus stops between Picktree Village and Washington Galleries Bus Station, then runs limited-stop, calling at Springwell Village Perseverance Arms, Wrekenton High Street Bus Link (Co-operative), Old Durham Road Ambulance Station (for Queen Elizabeth Hospital), Gateshead Interchange, Gateshead Hill Street (to set down), Newcastle foot of John Dobson Street (Venue) and Newcastle Eldon Square Bus Station. Most red arrows X1 buses connect at Washington Galleries with Connections 4 buses to Albany Way, Concord, Usworth, Follingsby Park, Wardley and Heworth.
