Vehicle Defect Report Card

- 1. It is the duty of every Driver to check their vehicle before going into service.
- 2. To help you with this task use the tick box provided.
- 3. If you find any defects, report them to Control or Engineering immediately.
- 4. If during your spell of duty a fault develops that you consider requires immediate attention or you would like advice, you should contact the Control Inspector via the radio or telephone.
- 5. If the vehicle develops a fault which does not need immediate attention and you consider it safe to continue, report the defect in the box provided.
- 6. The report is also used to comment on the vehicles performance or condition. The last driver of the vehicle MUST complete this section on return to the depot.
- 7. If an Engineer or other member of staff provides a substitute bus on the road they must inspect the vehicle before leaving the Depot and complete the card overleaf.
- 8. An effective vehicle defect reporting system is an essential part of the terms and conditions of the Company's "Operating Licence". This system is approved by the Department of Transport Vehicle Inspectorate. The Traffic Commissioner requires that the driver must sign this card when applicable.
