NOTICES

The fares shown in the fares book are as licensed by the Traffic Commissioners and no other fares shall be charged by any conductor.

Fares are subject to alteration and any amendments or addition to such fares will be notified for the immediate alteration of the fare tables.

The acceptance by a passenger of a Ticket issued by the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive shall be held to constitute a contract between the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive and the Passenger which shall be subject to these Conditions.

General—Passengers boarding between fare stages will be charged as from the previous stage point. Passengers booking to a place between fare stages will be charged to the stage point beyond.

"Ultimate" Tickets must be printed with the stage number at which passenger boards vehicle.

Tickets must be kept and shown on demand. Tickets are not valid for break of journey.

Tickets available on other Companies' Vehicles—Where tickets issued by the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive are available for the whole or a portion of the journey on other Companies' vehicles or on other Companies' routes, or where tickets are available for the return journey on the vehicle of another Company, the arrangements to secure these facilities have been made for the specific convenience of passengers and the acceptance of a ticket carrying with it such facilities is to be taken as evidence of an agreement whereby the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive is not under any circumstances responsible for delay, detention, loss or injury to the person or property of a passenger whilst travelling on another Company's vehicles.

Children's Fares—

(a) *Children, three and under fourteen years of age:*

Children who have attained the age of three years, but who have not attained the age of fourteen years, are conveyed at half the adult fare. Fractions of one penny to count as one penny. Minimum fare for children and scholars, 1p single.

(b) *Children under three years of age:*

Children under three years of age are conveyed free of charge provided they do not occupy a seat required by an adult and that not more than one such child accompanies each adult fare-paying passenger. Children under the age of three years in excess of those allowed to travel free of charge, are conveyed at children's fares.

Scholars up to the age of 15 years are allowed to travel at half fare to nearest 1p above when travelling to and from school only.

SCHOLARS IN POSSESSION OF CERTIFICATES issued by Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive are allowed to travel at half fare to the nearest 1p above when travelling to and from School only, but not available after 1800 hrs. on Mondays to Fridays and 1230 hrs. on Saturdays. These certificates are valid on all Services with the following exceptions: Services 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 16, 17, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 53, 54, 66, 67, 68, 69.

Valid on these Services North of Gateshead High Street or North of Gateshead Station ONLY:

Service 13 Valid between Croft Street and Wallsend Boundary ONLY.
Services 5, 43, 44, 48, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 306 NOT VALID on these Services.

Carriage of Dogs—Dogs will (subject to the absolute right of the Executive to refuse to carry them at any time) be conveyed on the Public Service Vehicles of the Executive at "owners risk" if accompanying a passenger under the following conditions:

(i) A charge of one-half the standard single journey fare to the nearest 1p above for the journey being made by the passenger will be made for dogs.

(ii) No charge will be made for guide dogs accompanying a blind person or for a lap dog which can be conveniently carried by the passenger.

(iii) No dogs are allowed on omnibus seats and the Executive reserve the right to refuse to carry any dog not under control or if it becomes or is likely to become a nuisance to passengers.

(iv) The Executive do not accept any liability howsoever caused for the loss or injury to dogs whilst being conveyed.

Greyhounds—Greyhounds will not be permitted on buses unless they are muzzled, and conductors are instructed that not more than two greyhounds are to be allowed on a single deck vehicle or two on each deck of a double deck vehicle.

Passengers' Luggage—Luggage must not be bulky or inconvenient, neither must it take up the gangway or seating space. It will only be conveyed at owner's risk and if the luggage can be conveyed without inconveniencing other passengers. The Executive will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage howsoever caused. Explosives or combustible materials may not be brought on the Executive's Public Service Vehicles and will not be conveyed in any circumstances whatever. Accumulators or batteries must not be placed on the racks or seats, and will not be conveyed unless contained in a proper carrier, and then only if they are placed on the floor of the vehicle. The Executive reserve the right to refuse trunks or other articles of a bulky or offensive nature. Bicycles, perambulators, non-folding pushchairs and non-folding Invalid Chairs will not be carried. No cumbersome articles or those in excess of 28 lb (excepting suitcases), may take up any space within the vehicle.

Military Warrants and British Railways Vouchers—The Conductor is to collect the voucher, enter his name on it and the value of tickets issued, and pay it in with his cash.

Service No. 5—Newcastle to Darras Hall

The Board marked "First Stop for Setting Down Passengers Kenton Bar" MUST always be displayed on journeys from the City. This condition is to be enforced.

This condition does NOT apply to the 0736 journey from the Haymarket to Darras Hall on Sunday mornings.

Service No. 306—Newcastle to Tynemouth

Employees of other Operators—Unless they are in possession of an Official Pass signed by the Divisional Manager of Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive, employees of other operators travelling on this service must pay the appropriate fares for the journeys taken.

Staff Warrants issued by the United Automobile Services Ltd. are NOT accepted.

OLD AGE PENSIONERS, BLIND AND DISABLED PERSONS CONCESSIONARY TRAVEL

Travel Concession Permit

Old Age Pensioners and certain Blind and Disabled Persons in possession of a Travel Concession Permit will be permitted to travel within the Passenger Transport Authority Area on Executive and National Bus Company vehicles "free of charge" as follows:

SUNDAYS AND BANK HOLIDAYS — All day.

MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS — Between 0930 hrs. and 1600 hrs. and between 1830 hrs. and 2200 hrs.

SATURDAYS — All day up to 2200 hrs.

All times of travel will be determined by the time of boarding.

Blind and Handicapped Persons Special Permits

Persons in possession of Blind and Handicapped Persons Special Permits will entitle the holders upon production to Free travel at all times within the Passenger Transport Authority Area.

Availability

The above passes are available throughout the length of all Executive Services in the North Division, and on all South Shields Services in the South Division.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930

Extract from the Public Service Vehicles (Conduct of Drivers, Conductors and Passengers) Regulations, 1936 and as amended 1946

- (1) A passenger must not wilfully alter or deface his ticket.
- (2) A passenger must—

Unless he is already the holder of a ticket in respect of that journey, or immediately upon demand declare the journey he intends to take or has taken and pay the conductor the fare for the whole of such journey and accept the ticket provided therefor.

(3) Show his ticket, if any, when required to do so to the conductor or other authorised person, or, if he fails so to show his ticket, pay the fare for the journey taken or to be taken by him.

(4) If he is the holder of a period or season ticket surrender that ticket at the expiry of the period for which it was issued to him if required to do so.

(5) A passenger in or on a vehicle who is reasonably suspected by the driver or conductor of contravening these regulations must give his name and address to a police constable or to the driver or conductor on demand.

EXTRACT FROM SECTION 135, ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1960 (ROAD SERVICE LICENCES)

Copies of the fare table shall be carried and be available for inspection in vehicles used on the Service.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS, 1934, No. 1268

ROAD TRAFFIC PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES

The Public Service Vehicles (Lost Property) Regulations, 1934, dated November 19th, 1934 and as amended 1958, made by the Minister of Transport

The Minister of Transport in exercise of the powers vested in him under or by virtue of the Road Traffic Acts, 1930 to 1934, (a) and of all other powers in that behalf vested in him hereby makes the following Regulations.

Short Title and Commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as "The Public Service Vehicles (Lost Property) Regulations, 1934" and shall come into force on 1st December, 1934.
- (2) The Public Service Vehicles (Lost Property) Regulations, 1933, (b) are hereby revoked.
- (3) Nothing in these Regulations shall:—
 - (a) affect the operation prior to the date hereof of the Public Service Vehicles (Lost Property) Regulations, 1933, or anything done or suffered under those Regulations, or
 - (b) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under these Regulations, or
 - (c) affect any fine or punishment incurred in respect of a breach of those Regulations, or
 - (d) affect any legal proceedings or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, fine or punishment; and any such legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such fine or punishment may be imposed as if these Regulations had not been made.

Definitions

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—
 - "Vehicle" means Public Service Vehicle;
 - "Driver" means a person licensed to drive a vehicle;
 - "Conductor" means a person licensed to act as conductor of a vehicle, or, in the case of a vehicle where there is no conductor, the driver;
 - "Operator" means the person who is the holder of a public service licence in respect of the vehicle in which any property is found.

Application of Regulations

3. These Regulations shall not apply in the case of property found in a vehicle belonging to the London Passenger Transport Board.

Property to be handed to Conductor

4. Any person who finds property accidentally left in a vehicle shall immediately hand it in the state in which he finds it to the conductor who shall deal with it in accordance with these Regulations.

Property to be handed to Operator or his Representative

5. Immediately before or on the termination of any journey the conductor shall as far as practicable search the vehicle for any property accidentally left therein, and shall, as soon as may be and in any case within 24 hours, hand such property together with any property handed to him under the preceding Regulations in the state in which it came into his possession to the operator of the service or his representative who shall give the conductor a receipt for the property:

Provided that any property found by or handed to a conductor may, if he goes off duty before the completion of the journey, either be dealt with by him in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation or be handed by him, in the state in which it came into his possession to the conductor who comes on duty in his place, who shall give him a receipt therefor and deal with it in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation:

Provided also that if, before such property has been handed to the operator or his representative, it is claimed by a person who satisfies the conductor that he is the owner, it shall be returned to that person forthwith, without fee or reward, on giving his name and address to the conductor who shall, as soon as may be, report the facts and give the claimant's name and address and a description of the property to the operator or his representative.

Record of Property

6. The operator's representative shall within 48 hours deliver or send for custody to the operator in the state in which he received it any property handed to him in pursuance of these Regulations, together with particulars of the property, the circumstances in which it was found and the name of the conductor into whose possession it first came or which it was found to the operator such particulars as aforesaid and the address of the place at which he has custody of the property, and in either case the operator shall keep a record of such particulars and of the ultimate disposal of the property under these Regulations, and such record shall at all reasonable times be available for inspection by a police officer or any person authorised to inspect records by the Traffic Commissioners for the Area in which such record is kept.

Safe Keeping of Property

7. The operator or his representative having the custody of property in pursuance of these Regulations shall retain the property in safe keeping until claimed by the owner thereof or disposed of in accordance with these Regulations:

Provided that official documents, including licences, passports and aliens' identity books, shall be returned forthwith to the appropriate Government department, local authority or other body or person by whom they were issued:

Provided also that where the name and address of the owner of any property, other than documents referred to in the preceding proviso, are readily ascertainable the operator or his representative shall forthwith notify him that the property is in his possession and may be claimed in accordance with these Regulations.

Unclaimed Property

8. If any property so retained by an operator or his representative be not within three months of the date when it was handed over by the conductor to the operator or his representative proved to his satisfaction to belong to a claimant, it shall thereupon vest in the operator who shall, as he thinks fit, either deliver such property to the conductor or without undue delay sell such property and in respect of any article which realises a sum in excess of 10p shall award to the conductor (up to an amount not exceeding £4) one-twelfth of the proceeds of such sale. For the purpose of computing the amount so due to the conductor any fraction of a penny shall be reckoned as a penny:

Provided that any documents, which have not been returned to the owner or other appropriate person under Regulation 7 hereof and which have not been claimed by a person entitled to their return before the expiration of the aforesaid period of three months, shall not be delivered to the conductor or sold but shall be dealt with in such manner as the operator or his representative may deem appropriate.

Claimed Property

9. (a) If any property while it is so retained by an operator or his representative be claimed and the claimant prove to the satisfaction of such operator or representative that it belongs to him, it shall thereupon be delivered to him upon payment to the operator or his representative of a sum not exceeding 5p and in the case of property of a value exceeding 10p an additional sum (up to an amount not exceeding £4) of one-twelfth of the value of the property which additional sum shall be awarded by the operator to the conductor. For the purpose of computing the amount so due to the conductor any fraction of 1p shall be reckoned as 1p.

(b) For the purpose of this Regulation the value of the property shall be deemed to be such sum as may be agreed between the claimant and the operator or his representative, or, failing agreement, such sum as may be fixed by a licensed appraiser. Any fee payable to such licensed appraiser shall be paid by the claimant.

Perishable Property

10. If any property so retained by an operator or his representative appears to him to be of a perishable nature, and it be not claimed and proved to his satisfaction to belong to the claimant within 48 hrs. from the time when it was found he may thereupon destroy or otherwise dispose of it as he sees fit and if such property is sold the operator shall reward the conductor in the manner provided in Regulation 8 hereof:

Provided that any property which is or becomes objectionable may be destroyed or disposed of at any time in the discretion of the operator or his representative.

Conductor entitled to award

11. The conductor into whose possession the property first came shall alone be entitled to an award under the provisions of Regulations 8, 9 and 10 hereof.

Cost of packing and carriage

12. Where any property is forwarded to a claimant all costs of packing and carriage reasonably incurred shall be paid to the operator or his representative by the claimant.

Examination of Property

13.—Where any property is contained in a package, bag or other receptacle, the operator or his representative may cause such receptacle to be opened and the contents examined if he deems it necessary to do so for the purpose either:

- (a) of identifying and tracing the owner of the property, or
- (b) of ascertaining the nature of its contents.

Proof of Ownership

14.—Where any property is claimed by any person, the operator or his representative may require the claimant to open any receptacle in which it may be contained and to submit the contents to examination for the purpose of establishing his claim to ownership.

Penalty

15. If any person acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any of the requirements of these Regulations he shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £5.

Interpretation

16. The Interpretation Act, 1889 (a) applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONDUCTORS

IGNORANCE OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS BOOK WILL NOT
BE ACCEPTED AS AN EXCUSE FOR NEGLIGENCE OR OMISSION OF DUTY

1. **Alteration of Rules**—These Rules and Regulations may be amended by the Executive as required.
2. **Condition of Service**—All servants shall hold their respective situations subject to full compliance with these Rules and Regulations.
3. **Performance of Other Duties**—All employees will be expected to perform such other duties as the Executive may direct.
4. **Grievances**—A hearing by the Divisional Manager is open to every employee who has any grievance to state, and reports or suggestions for the improvement of the service will always receive consideration.
5. **Wages Ceasing to Accrue**—The wages of any employee shall cease to accrue on notification of suspension from duty.
6. **Gambling**—All forms of gambling, including betting, etc., and the use of playing cards or dice within the depot or canteen or other property of the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive is forbidden.
7. **Soliciting Subscriptions**—Employees are not allowed to solicit or collect subscriptions from servants of the T.P.T.E., for any purpose whatever without the permission of the Executive.
8. **Summonses**—Send to the Manors Office all summonses or complaints from passengers or others with particulars.
9. **Fines**—The Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive will not pay fines for which the employees of the T.P.T.E. become liable.
10. **Practice for Appointment**—Before appointment, new entrants are required to practice on a vehicle under the instruction of a regular employee on service duty until they are certified by an official as competent, and when appointed, will be placed on the spare list and will succeed to regular service duties in order of seniority.
11. **Trainees**—Regular employees are expected, to the best of their ability, to assist new entrants to the service, in learning the duties.
12. **Addresses**—Change of address (or name in case of marriage) must be notified to the Depot Clerk on special form provided.
13. **Behaviour**—Obey promptly the orders of those in authority, and be courteous in demeanour to associates and the public generally, and abstain from the use of profane language.
14. **General Appearance**—Be neat and clean in appearance, giving special attention to boots and uniform.
15. **Reporting and Taking Up Duty**—Report to the Depot Clerk promptly at the time posted up for your respective duties. When taking a vehicle from the Depot, examine same, and see that it is in order with full equipment and properly cleaned. Any irregularity must be reported at once to the Depot Clerk. In the absence of such report it will be presumed that the vehicle is in good order and complete in all its equipment.
Employees on spare and not required for a vehicle will act on the instructions of the Depot Clerk.
16. **Wearing Uniform**—Wear at all times when on duty or attending at Manors Office or at court, the uniform provided by the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive. Uniforms must be kept clean and in good order. The jacket and great-coat must always be worn fully buttoned. Mufflers or jerseys must not be conspicuous. Employees while in uniform must not wear any flower, emblem, or decoration of any kind, except on special occasions, and then only with the permission of the Executive.

17. **Meals**—Suitable times for meals will be provided as far as possible, but where it is necessary for any meals to be taken while on duty, they must be consumed at the terminus and not on the vehicle en route.

18. **Sickness**—Inform the Depot Clerk at the earliest possible moment when unable to attend work through sickness or other unforeseen causes, and so enable the Depot Clerk to obtain another man to work the duty. A medical certificate must be furnished when required. (Saturdays and public holidays compulsory.)

19. **Timekeeping**—Have a reliable watch when on duty.

20. **Running of Services**—See that the service vehicles are run exactly in accordance with the timetables (or to instructions of Inspectors or other responsible officials) and perform the number of journeys stated on the running card; any deviations must be reported in writing. If, owing to heavy traffic or other cause beyond control, vehicles arrive late at termini, the return journey must be resumed as near to schedule time as possible.

21. **Civility**—Answer politely and respectfully any enquiry that may be made by passengers.

22. **Ejecting Passengers**—Avoid all unnecessary noise and confusion when dealing with a disorderly or objectionable passenger; and, if necessary, the name and address of the offender must be obtained, together with the names and addresses of witnesses, and the occurrence reported to the Divisional Manager.

23. **Giving Passengers into Custody**—Passengers must not be given into custody except in cases of assault, without the permission of an Inspector or other responsible Officer of the T.P.T.E.

24. **Defects and Obstructions**—Report to Inspectors or other officers of the T.P.T.E., as soon as possible, any defects or accidental obstructions that may be observed and which may cause delay to the service. In cases of intentional obstruction the police should be called, the names and addresses of persons witnessing the obstruction should be obtained, and a report sent to the Divisional Manager.

25. **Accidents**—Report immediately in writing in ink on the form provided for the purpose, any accident (however trivial) which may happen to, or may be caused by your vehicle, whereby any damage is caused or person is injured, no matter how slight or in what manner or by whose fault it may have occurred. Stop the vehicle at once and ascertain the extent of the damage or injury. Obtain the name and address of the person or persons injured or causing the damage, and obtain the names and addresses of persons witnessing the occurrence. It is of the utmost importance in the interests of the Conductor to have the names of reliable witnesses. No comment should be made regarding the accident.

26. **Personal Injury**—Show sympathy and render every assistance in cases of personal injury.

27. **Leaving Service**—Deliver up uniform, monies, and all other articles belonging to the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive when leaving the service; accrued wages will not be paid until the clothing, Fare Book, and all other monies or articles belonging to the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive which have been supplied for duty purposes shall have been delivered up. If any article is not returned or is damaged by improper use, the cost of such article or of the repair of such damage shall be a debt due by the servant to the Tyneside Passenger Transport Executive and will be deducted from any pay then due, or if such pay be found insufficient to meet the claim, will be a debt recoverable at law. Any Employee who resigns his appointment must give seven days' clear notice in writing of his intention to the Personnel Officer.

28. **Bag Change**—Have in your possession when reporting for duty the correct bag change provided by the T.P.T.E.

29. **Stopping places**—**CALM OUT THE STOPPING PLACES AND BE ON THE LOOK-OUT FOR PERSONS WISHING TO JOIN A VEHICLE**, at recognised stopping places.

30. **Attention to Passengers**—Assist passengers entering and alighting, being especially attentive to cripples, blind or aged persons, and women with children; and when such passengers are alighting, see that no vehicle is approaching from which they might receive injury. Find seating accommodation when possible for standing passengers by seeing that the longitudinal seats are fully and properly occupied.

31. **Position of Conductor**—Take up a position on the platform when not collecting fares or engaged in other duties.

32. **Reversing at Terminus—All Vehicles**—Take up a position on the road at the rear of vehicle and be ready to signal the driver with whistle to stop, if necessary.

33. **Ventilation**—Attend to the ventilation of the vehicle. On arriving at Depot close all ventilators so that the vehicle is ready for the mechanical wash.

34. **Indicators**—See that all indicators are changed at terminus.

CONDUCTORS ARE PROHIBITED

35. **Exchanging Duties**—From allowing a substitute to perform their duties and from exchanging duty with any other employee, without prior permission from the Depot Clerk.

36. **No Relief**—From leaving or running the vehicle off service without permission (accidents or breakdowns excepted). In the event of a "relief" not arriving at the appointed time, the Depot Clerk must be notified, and the crew on duty must continue the service until they are relieved, and will be remunerated for the extra work done.

37. **Smoking**—From smoking, or reading newspapers or books, in or on the bus, while on service.

38. **Intoxicating Drink**—(a) Conductors and Drivers are prohibited from drinking intoxicating liquor when proceeding to or whilst on duty.

(b) Any Conductor or Driver who, when reporting for duty or being on duty, is found under the influence of intoxicating liquor will not be allowed to resume work that day and will be dismissed.

(c) Any Conductor or Driver who, in the uniform of the T.P.T.E., enters a public house shall (except where such Conductor or Driver has completed all duties for the remainder of the day) not be allowed to resume work that day and will be dismissed.

(d) The expression "duty" shall include layover and relief times.

39. **Unnecessary Conversation**—From making disparaging remarks about the management of the T.P.T.E., or from entering into unnecessary conversation with passengers.

40. **Occupying Seats**—From occupying a seat on any vehicle when there are any passengers standing or from standing on the platform, when proceeding to or from duty.

41. **Signals to Drivers**—From signalling to the driver by stamping a foot on the floor or kicking the dash or any other part of the vehicle or by shouting or whistling. From blowing the whistle inside the vehicle, except when in an emergency.

CONDUCTORS MUST NOT ALLOW

42. **Official Passes**—Any person not in possession of a permit of the T.P.T.E. to travel without paying the proper fare.

43. **Intoxicated Persons**—An intoxicated person to enter a vehicle.

44. **Smoking**—Any person to smoke except in the upper saloon.

45. **Collections**—Any person to collect money or distribute advertising literature or pamphlets of any description, or sell newspapers or any other article unless permission has been granted by the Divisional Manager.

46. **Seats**—Any person to stand on or place their feet on the seats, or stand on the platform (except by permit) or when passengers are entering or leaving.

CONDUCTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR

47. **Fares**—The fare of every passenger riding in or upon the vehicle, in accordance with the table of fares.

48. **Shorts**—All tickets received by them. Every ticket not returned or accounted for must be paid for by the Conductor at its issue or face value. Payment of shortages may be enforced before the Conductor is allowed to resume work, or may be deducted from his wages.

49. **Bad Money**—All defaced or mutilated tokens or counterfeit or foreign coins, or any silver, or copper coins which are perforated, or defaced, taken by them.

50. **Negligence**—All injury and damage caused by their neglect or carelessness and all accidents, delays, lost journeys, etc. All unclaimed luggage or articles found on the vehicle and not returned to Depot.

COLLECTION OF FARES

51. **Fares**—Conductors shall begin to collect the fares from passengers as soon as the vehicle leaves a terminus, and afterwards as each passenger enters.

52. **Excess Fares**—Whenever a passenger travels beyond the stage to which the fare paid entitles him to travel the Conductor shall collect the excess fare.

53. **Cancelled Tickets**—A ticket once issued must not be re-issued. A Conductor shall not have in his possession a ticket which has been previously issued.

54. **Passengers Unable to Pay Fare**—Passengers to fill in agreement form which can be obtained from Depot Clerk.

55. **Passengers Refusing To Pay Fare**—In all cases of passengers refusing to pay their fare, the name and address of the passengers and of one or more persons witnessing the occurrence must be obtained, and a full report of the circumstances sent to the Divisional Manager.

56. **Called Off Duty**—Should a Conductor be called off duty for any cause except relief, he shall at once hand over his machine, cash, waybills, unsold tickets, box, and other articles to any officer of the T.P.T.E. having authority to receive same.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CONDUCTORS IN CASES OF DISPUTE WITH PASSENGERS

57. **Refusing to Leave the Vehicle, already Full, if Requested to do so**—Obtain name and address.

58. **Passengers Refusing to Leave Conductor's Platform when Requested to do so**—Obtain name and address.

59. **Refusing to Pay Fare on Demand or to Pay Excess Fare**—Obtain name and address.

60. **Offering Old Coin or Counterfeit Money in Payment of Fare**—This must be refused and proper coin demanded. If the latter is refused, take name and address.

61. **Passengers in State of Intoxication**—Must not be allowed to enter vehicle. If, however, found on the vehicle, should be requested to leave.

62. **Refusing to Show Ticket when Requested, and Refusing Name and Address**—Refer the matter to an Inspector, or Police Officer.

63. **Passengers Smoking inside Vehicle or on Platform after being Cautioned not to do so**—Obtain name and address.

64. **Committing a Nuisance on the Vehicle**—Obtain names and addresses of witnesses, and inform the Police if available.

65. **Obstructing the Conductor whilst in the Execution of his Duty**—Obtain names and addresses, together with witnesses.

66. **Passengers Doing Any Wilful Damage to the T.P.T.E. Property**—Obtain name and address, also those of witnesses.

67. In all cases of dispute, the names and addresses should be obtained.

In all matters not fully covered by these Rules and Regulations, Conductors are expected to use common sense and discretion in performing their duties.

SIGNALS

Signal to the Driver:—

1 Bell	Stop at next stopping place.
2 Bells	To start.
3 Bells	To stop at once.
4 Bells	Vehicle full.

THE 'ULTIMATE' TICKET SYSTEM

1. The 'Ultimate' Ticket System gives absolute security to the conductor. No ticket or waybill mistakes can remain unrectified.

2. Every ticket requisitioned by the conductor is signed for and debited to his own Balance Sheet. A continuous record is maintained of tickets debited, and all tickets charged for on waybills are credited to the conductor's account.

3. The Box Balance Sheet showing ticket and cash records is balanced weekly. Any conductor can see his records on making application to the Head Ticket Clerk.

THE 'ULTIMATE' TICKET MACHINE

4. The 'Ultimate' Ticket Machine is an automatic ticket rack with five separate compartments.

5. It has a stage indicator and class selector spindle which must always be set, so that when issuing a ticket it shows the stage at which the passenger boarded, printed in the appropriate section, i.e., **Single—Exchange—Return**.

6. There are five ejector levers and five press buttons. Pressure on a lever produces a single ticket. Simultaneous pressure on both a lever and the corresponding double issue button produces a double ticket—the first is printed as a single ticket, and the second has the serial number blocked out.

7. There are five numerators on the machine. Four of these record the number of double issues made from the compartments served. The fifth which is always used for 7p tickets, is the total counter, and registers the total number of tickets issued from all compartments.

8. The carbon ribbon must be used in six separate positions to give maximum use with clear printing.

- first, in normal position when new ribbon is used;
- second, move ribbon just over one-quarter inch to right;
- third, move ribbon just over one-quarter inch to right again; then turn ribbon around, or over, as instructed and repeat.

9. In the event of a machine becoming defective, the depot clerk or an inspector must be informed and a replacement machine will be issued at the first opportunity.

10. **Emergency Method of Ticket Issue**—When machine is defective all tickets issued by the Emergency Method MUST BE STAGED by the Conductor using indelible pencil or pen. If "double-issue" tickets are required, the Conductor must indicate this by stage numbering the first ticket and crossing out the serial number of the second ticket. All numbers of tickets issued by the emergency method MUST BE ENTERED ON THE IRREGULARITIES SECTION OF WAYBILL.

NOTE: The machine requires no oiling at all.

ULTIMATE TICKETS

11. There are five denominations of tickets, 1p, 3p, 4p, 5p, and 7p.

12. The following are the ticket combinations for all Services:

Fare	Ticket Combination
1p	1 at 1p
2p	1 double 1p
3p	1 at 3p
4p	1 at 4p
5p	1 at 5p
6p	1 double 3p
7p	1 at 7p
8p	1 double 4p
9p	1 double 4p plus 1 at 1p

12p	1 double 4p plus 1 at 4p
13p	1 double 5p plus 1 at 3p

13. "Ultimate" tickets are packed in rolls of 1,000, and spare rolls should be placed in the correct sequence in the special ticket-roll tray.

14. Upon reaching the last 30 of any roll it should be unrolled and the adhesive tab joined to the next roll in sequence. Roll the old tickets around the new roll. Always make the joins dead level or a stoppage might be caused.

15. When replenishing the machine with tickets ensure that the rolls are perfectly flat so that they run freely in the compartment.

16. When tickets have been ejected they should be torn with an upwards and sideways movement against the cutters.

17. In the event of a stoppage in any compartment the tickets affected must be issued from the back of the machine by the emergency method until a replacement machine is received.

18. The total of tickets issued should agree with the Total Dial reading. The cause of any discrepancies must be noted on the waybill.

19. Where a change of route takes place the counter and ticket readings must be entered on the back of the waybill and a line drawn beneath them.

20. On completion of duty it is essential that all ticket numbers and counter readings are entered accurately on the waybill.

21. It is most important that tickets are used in the correct numerical and alphabetical sequence, and that adequate supplies of tickets are carried at all times.

STARTING DAY'S DUTY

1. Report to Depot Clerk for your duty.

Take Ultimate machine box and canvas cash bag (placed therein by Depot Staff from previous day's cash deposit made by you) from your locker—make sure you have the correct box, machine, and cash bag, if not, report the fact immediately to the Depot Clerk.

2. Re-lock the locker lid. This is for your own security. When lids are left open there is a risk of canvas cash bag on replacement by Cash Room staff, falling through onto the floor, being lost or removed by an unauthorised person. Also, lids left open are liable to become broken from their hinges.

3. Make certain you have a fresh waybill for the day's duty. Check your tickets, see you have sufficient stocks of all values. Tickets are obtainable at your home Depot only, and cannot be obtained at West Walls or Handysides Sub-Offices.

DURING DAY'S DUTY

1. Always use your combination lock on your Ultimate machine box—it is provided for your own security. Failure to do so will mean that lost or stolen tickets will be charged for.

2. During relief—look after your box and machine and don't mix them with any others.

3. Look after monies collected by you during the day's duty, and if you give change for "notes" be sure to give and receive the correct monies.

COMPLETING DAY'S DUTY

1. Check all monies received by you and enter up the Waybill correctly—never leave your money unattended. Secure monies and Waybill in cash bag and make certain this bears your own box number.

The following are common errors:—

(a) Name, Date, Bag No., Pay Check No. and Signature—These must be fully and legibly completed for correct identification of Conductor.

(b) Entries on Waybills do not agree with contents of bag—Conductors must check all cash thoroughly on completion of duty, and immediately before making out Waybill—make certain that Waybill is a true record of cash deposited.

(c) Alteration on Waybill—The figures to be corrected should be crossed out and new accurate figures entered above.

(d) Money Changed after Waybill Completed—If change is given out after the Waybill has been completed the appropriate alteration must be made thereon before the bag is finally secured and deposited into the safe.

(e) Additions—Frequent mistakes are made in additions—Ensure accuracy to avoid queries later.

(f) Always check pockets to ensure that all cash collected is deposited at the correct time. In the event of cash being left in pockets and subsequently discovered it is essential that Conductors shall pay in such money direct to the Ticket Department, Manors, within three days, and late credit claimed for same. On no account must such "late credit-money" be deposited into the Night Safe.

2. Deposit canvas cash bag in night safe—This is Your Responsibility Entirely, and you must not rely upon anyone else doing it for you. Lift lid of the safe, place bag into the trap, drop the lid, lift lid again to make sure the bag has entered the safe, and replace lid. If you think that the bag has jammed, report to the Depot Clerk immediately. Don't leave money in bag on the counter—this has been done on a number of occasions by staff rushing for last buses. All cash not deposited will be charged against the Conductor.

3. Hand any lost property to the Depot Clerk.

4. If returned canvas cash bag is in your locker, place them in your box; if bag should have been there but is not, report that fact to the Depot Clerk immediately. Place locked box in locker and lock the lid of the locker.

At all times look after and use your combination lock and locker key—they are your safeguard. If you lose either of these, report the fact immediately.

IMPORTANT. Lockers must be used only for Ultimate machine box and canvas pay-in cash bag—other items of equipment, such as leather cash bag, articles of uniform, must not be placed in lockers.

1. The Service No. must be shown on all journeys, i.e., Regular Services, Workmen's Services, Scholars' Services, and D.H.S.S. Special Services, in addition the destination of the journey must be displayed.

Service 3, 4—Cowgate on upper front and side, and Circle on lower front
Service 18, 19—Walker do. do.
Service 41, 42—Spital Tongues
Heaton Road } on upper front and side.
Circle via R.V.I. on lower front.

4. **Duplicate** is provided on both upper and lower front screens and must be shown in addition to the destination if duplicate journey is being operated. (In the case of Service 13 show Duplicate on side screen).

5. **"All-Night" Services**—Show Central Station on Upper Front and Side, and show West End or East End on lower front.

6. **Gosforth Park Race Special Services**—All Buses operating on Race Special Services will show "Races" on lower front screens and "Blank" on Upper Front and Side screens. The Special No. of the Race Special must be displayed on the Service No. Indicator Screen.
