• Monkwearmouth Station Museum

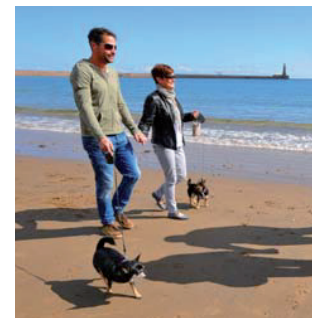
The impressive stone columns and statement architecture of this station are a gateway to discovering Sunderland's transport history. Loads of fun and activities aimed at younger visitors too.

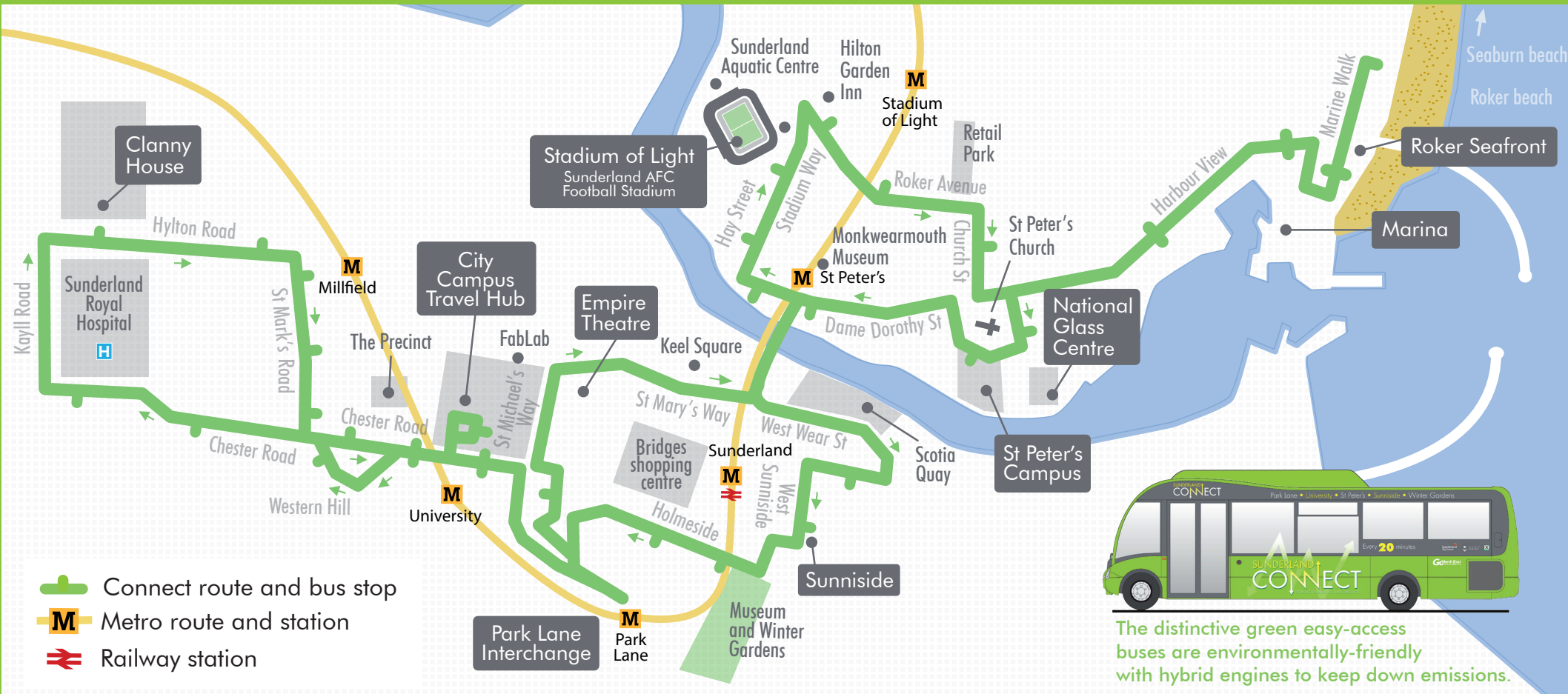
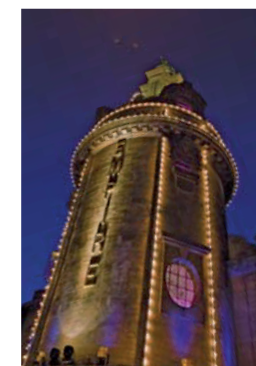

Fares

Single ticket - £1.25

All day ticket - £2.10

Family day ticket – £5.00

(one or two adults and up to three children)

Weekly ticket - £8.00

FREE travel for University of Sunderland students and staff who show valid university ID.

Child Fares

Children with an Under 16 Pop card travel for 60p single or, buy a Child All-day Ticket (CAT) and travel all day on all public transport in Tyne and Wear for £1.10. Children without an Under 16 Pop card travel for 80p single.

Other tickets and passes

If you have a Concessionary Travel Pass, you can travel for free after 9.30am on weekdays, and all day on weekends and bank holidays. Network One Travel Tickets including zone four are also valid on Sunderland Connect.

If your journey includes other Go North East services, you can buy or use a Buzzfare or Get Around ticket (for school children and students).

Buy a Transfare if you're using Metro before or after your Sunderland Connect journey. Or buy a Network One Day Rover ticket for all day travel on all public transport in Tyne and Wear.

Explorer and Plusbus tickets are also accepted.

Sunderland SmartZone is the smart way to get around Sunderland by bus. Tickets are valid on all Go North East, Arriva and Stagecoach bus services in the area which means you can jump on the first bus that comes.

Prices correct at June 2016.

Sunderland Connect buses have audio visual displays to help passengers with visual and hearing impairments, as well as benefitting visitors and students.
